

There has been much deliberation at government level recently surrounding the appeals process for this year. Due to the nature of the amount of material that is needed should an appeal be requested, we have opted to set up a tab on the website to hold all of the information. Appealing is a two-step process this year. Step one is an internal centre review where students can ask that the grade be checked for administrative errors and then step two, which can only follow on once step one is checked and completed, where it is felt that the judgement does not reflect the materials. All further information on this matter is on our school website. This is predominantly completed by the awarding organisations and will take around 42 days to complete.
